## Detecting the Webcam Through VoiceThread

Open <u>VoiceThread</u> using a supported browser:

**Firefox**: We recommend using the latest version of Mozilla's Firefox. <u>Get it here!</u> **Chrome:** We recommend using the latest version of Google Chrome. <u>Get it here!</u>

After you have opened VoiceThread, sign in to your account and click "Create." You will then be directed to a series of options, in which you will click "My webcam."

1- To make sure that your camera

has been detected by your computer after allowing Access, hover your mouse in the record panel area, right click on your mouse and select "Settings."



2- Click on the Webcam Icon:





3- Select from the drop down list the correct webcam that you have. If you are using a webcam that is built into the computer, select "Default."
