Atomic Learning offers thousands of short tutorials covering common software applications and computer tasks.


#### **How do I access Atomic Learning?**

We have integrated access to Atomic Learning within Blackboard so that students and faculty can access the tutorials at no cost and without re-authenticating in the following areas:







1- In your Blackboard course, navigate to the Content Area you want to put Atomic Learning videos in. Click on "Build Content".



2-Under "Mashups" click "Atomic Learning".




3-Search the Atomic Learning Library for videos. Select the application or subject. You can choose a





5-Select the video(s) you wish to add. You can preview videos before adding them.









